

Egypt is ranked among the Top Ten apparel sourcing countries to watch in 2022, according to Global data's Apparel intelligence center of Just style.






Apparel exports witnessed a remarkable rise of recorded \$2billion which is considered a historical increase that has not been achieved before






Apparel Egyptian Exports To United States

Egyptian Apparel Exports To US achieved a Rise of in 2021 compared to 2020










Egyptian Apparel Exports To EU achieved a Rise of in 2021 compared to 2020



Restructuring plan for the public sector enterprises includes:

- Merging 30 spinning and weaving companies into 9 companies, along with merging cotton trading and ginning companies into one company.
- The development of the first gin in Fayoum Governorate to replace the 25 old gins with new gins.
- Inauguration of the largest spinning and weaving factory in the world in Al-Mahalla Al-Kubra which accommodate more than 182 thousand spinning mills, with an average production capacity of 30 tons of yarn / day.
- 550 Mn. US\$ are being spent on up to date machinery from spinning, weaving, dyeing and finishing to confection.
- Utilizing 100% Egyptian Cotton Giza 95,86,94,92 and 96 for all yarn counts ranging from 10 Ne compact to 180 Ne compact.
 - responsible for the marketing of different products of the Holding Company for Cotton, Spinning, Weaving and Clothing under one brand.

APPAREL EXPORT COUNCIL OF EGYPT INAPHUL INTERIOR INTERIOR

- The new industrial complex in Badr City includes six factories, including one for thin yarn, another for thick yarn, three for preparing raw materials for weaving, and another for dyeing and printing.
- Built on an area of 430 acres with total production capacity with 1557 Tons of yarns, fabrics and dying which include 4500 tons of fine yarn per day, a thick spinning factory, and a knitting factory. This factory provides 1350 new direct jobs.

















The Cotton Museum, traces the history of cotton in Egypt and the world. On display are manuscripts and legislative decrees on cotton, antique embroidered fabrics, illustrations, information and samples of all botanical varieties in the world, from the extinct to the most recent.



Investments Projects in Egypt



Golden Triangle Project:

The project aims to create new industrial and mining projects on 6,000 square kilometers extending from the Red Sea cities of Safaga and Al Qusayr to Eastern Qena in Upper Egypt. The Egyptian government is targeting total investments worth \$16.5 billion within 30 years after implementation.




Offers existing ecosystem and access to markets supported with accessibility to 6 PORTS & 2 AIRPORTS, Strong cost competitiveness for manufacturing, attractive financial incentives, robust regulatory support for investors and Provides infrastructure within the entire region as well. Total job creation is estimated at 1 million over 15 years.

Investors Incentives in the Industrial Zone

- 100% ownership by foreign Investors.
- > 0% tax and duties on all machines, equipment, tools, and raw materials as long as they are produced for export uses.
- Competitive income tax rate on the net profit, newly established companies can benefit up to 7 years of exempted income tax.
- Competitive tax rate on wages, salaries, bonuses, incentives.
